COURSE DESCRIPTIONS

(All classes are limited)

KPT: (Kindergarten Puppy Training) An 8 Week course. To begin positive conditioning for proper behavior in the home; proper socializing skills with people and other dogs; an introduction to obedience, vet exams, agility, tracking and tricks! **8 -16 weeks of age.**

JR. BEGINNERS: An 8 Week course. To train the puppy who is too old for the KPT Course but may not be mentally or physically mature enough to handle the more structured Beginners Course. Lessons will include walking on a loose leash, coming when called, down and sit stays, tricks and social interaction between people and other dogs. At least **4 months of age.**

ATTENTION CLASS: A new 6 Week course which will teach the dog to focus his/her attention fully on the handler. This is a first level course in preparation for any type of future showing. More advanced attention courses may be added at a later date.

BEGINNERS: An 8 Week course. Basic home and street manners and obedience with special attention to behavioral problems. All AKC Novice ring exercises are included. **Some** dogs may be ready at 4 months, however, check with your trainer.

ADVANCED BEGINNERS: A 10 Week course. AKC Novice Obedience to begin to prepare your dog for the ring. You and your dog **MUST** have taken Jr. Beginners or Beginners.

ADVANCED BEGINNERS / CGC: A 6 Week course developed for the dog/handler team which has completed Beginners but may not be quite ready for the Novice course/drop-in class. The CGC is a 2 part program that stresses responsible pet ownership and good manners for the dogs. The course culminates in the 10 step AKC Canine Good Citizens test.

BEGINNING RALLY: A 6 Week course. Rally is a sport in which the dog and handler move through a course of directional signs in a manner similar to rally Car Racing. In the course all novice rally stations will be individually taught. Handlers will learn to do the various stations correctly as well as improve their dog's performance and their handling. A Beginner Obedience Course is required.

ADVANCED RALLY: A 6 Week course, developed to teach the dog and handler all of the Advanced and Excellent rally stations. The handler/dog team will learn to do the various Novice/Advanced/Excellent stations correctly as a team. Novice Rally students may join this course.

FREE-STYLE DANCE: A 6 Week course. To teach dog and handler 20-24 basic free-style moves. Smooth transitions and combining moves will be touched on. Due to the format of this class **NO AGGRESSIVE DOGS** will be permitted.

SHOW PREPARATION CLASS: A 12 Week course to prepare the student for obedience competition. Lessons covered; teaching both the handler and dog how to move their bodies in sync with each other; the heeling exercise is broken into mini-pieces and parts; for more information on all the exercises covered, equipment and supplies needed, please check out our web page; www.bskddogtraining.com.

CONFORMATION: An 8 Week course (2 hour class). Designed to teach the first-time competitor the proper way to show his/her dog to the dog's best advantage. Weekly homework includes lessons on

breeds, structure and movement of dogs, presentation, judging, AKC show rules. "What Wins and Why". Cost of Course includes materials.

NOVICE COURSE: A 6 Week, 2 hour course; developed to teach the first-time obedience exhibitor the rules and regulations for Novice, Open & Utility classes. Each week is divided into 1 hour of floor work with the owner/dog team, the second hour will be in the Library for weekly lessons including AKC show rules, presentation, judging, how to fill out the entry form. The instructors will aide in determining when the dog/handler team is ready for entry into a show.

AGILITY: An 8 Week course. To teach the dog and handler the basics of agility. Safety is stressed in use of equipment. Jumps, teeter. A-frame, dog walk, table, closed and open tunnels, are taught. A basic obedience course is required as is off-lead control. **DOGS MUST BE 15 MONTHS OLD TO ENROLL**, Class size is very limited.

INTERMEDIATE AGILITY: A 6 Week course. To work on advanced skills for competition. **This course is required before the student may attend any of the Drop-In classes.** Class size is very limited.

AGILITY I COURSE: A 4-week course designed to teach the foundational attention and ground work which is critical to future agility. We will be covering the theory of clicker training (clicker is not mandatory, but highly recommended), attention, targeting, toys, warm-ups, contact behavior, start line activities, jumping style and directionals, as well as reviewing the obedience basics. A basic obedience course is a pre-requisite for this course (dogs must be non-aggressive, and be able to sit stay, down stay, walk on a loose lead, and come when called while there are outside distractions). Course is limited to 6 students.

AGILITY II COURSE: A 6-week course designed to teach the dog and handler basic obstacle performance with some simple sequencing. All obstacles will be introduced (including teeter and weave poles), with safety and correct obstacle performance being stressed. To provide a safe, low stress learning experience, all obstacles are initially taught at an easier/lower level and progress through multiple class levels toward the desired competition performance. A basic obedience course and the agility foundations course is a pre-requisite for this course (dogs must be non-aggressive, and be able to sit stay, down stay, walk on a loose lead, and come when called while there are outside distractions). Unsupervised drop-in on equipment is not allowed. Course is limited to 6 students.

CLICKER TRAINING: A 6 Week course. An introduction to using clickers and the principles of "operant conditioning". Emphasis on individual problem solving - manners, obedience, conformation etc. Contact **Stephanie Price**.

TRACKING: An 8 Week course. To prepare the dog and handler for TD, TDX, and VST tests. Also teaches the handler ground and air conditions, mapping, track plotting and prepares the team for AKC testing. Contact **BSKD desk**.

PRIVATE LESSONS: Available at your home or at the Center from most BSKD trainers. Check with your trainer regarding hourly fees. A \$10 per hour building rental if done at the Center.
